### **Enrollment Update**

South Florida Workforce and the Department of Children and Families were recently advised that the Coalition's enrollment target for children in BG5 (transitional child care) has been reached. Effective **July 1, 2007**, there will be **NO** referrals issued to these clients (BG5). Enrollment for children in BG8 had previously been closed.

CDS will continue to process referrals received **prior** to July 1, 2007 until July 16, 2007, and **NO** BG5 referrals will be accepted **after July 16, 2007**. As providers, you should see **no additional enrollments** in these **two** categories (BG5 and BG8). The **only** categories now eligible for enrollment are BG1 (at-risk) and BG3 (TANF).

\*Please note that this does **not** affect clients who are scheduled for re-determination.

## Reminder: The "10 Day" Rule

Please remember that when parents are provided vouchers for care, they are given **five (5) days** to enroll their children. Providers are then given **48 hours** to send that enrollment data to CDS. If the child does not appear enrolled in the EFS within **10** days, they are terminated and their voucher is no longer valid.

\*Providers, once you receive the voucher, please send enrollment data to CDS right away, and do not accept **ANY** vouchers that are over 10 days old!

# Updated Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Rates and Parent Sliding Fee Scale

Each year the Federal Government adjusts the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) which could affect the eligibility of clients and/or the fees they pay for child care. The Coalition decided **not** to change the parent fees this year; however, if the parent's income level has changed they will pay according to that income.
