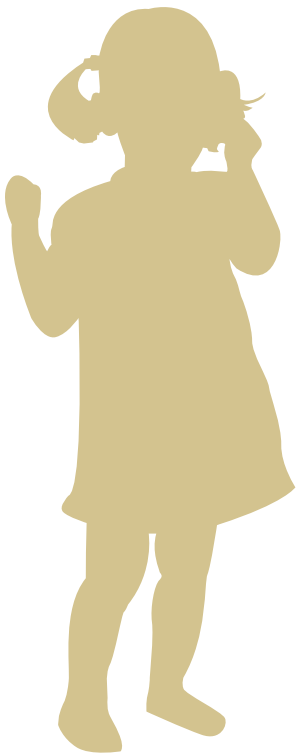


Refugee Child Care Services

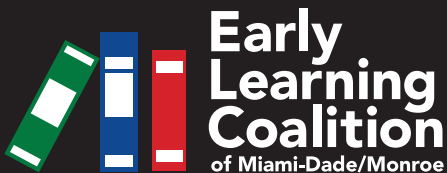


Child care services are provided to children of eligible refugees/entrants whose parents are enrolled in Refugee Services-funded employment and adult education services, and Refugee Resettlement-funded match grant programs. Services are available on a part-time or full-time basis depending on the phase of participation in the employment program. Care is provided for children ages birth to 12 years old and is limited to 24 months of time.

Services are provided to assist refugees/entrant families in becoming or remaining economically self-sufficient.

Families need a referral to access services. A referral may be obtained through one of several Refugee Voluntary Agencies in Miami-Dade county.
