Will successful respondents be considered vendors or sub-recipients for purposes of the auditing and financial disclosure requirements contained within Exhibit 12 if the respondent's offerings include only proprietary curricula, materials and training? If considered a vendor, how should a respondent complete Exhibit 12 for purposes of the RFP response?

**Answer:** Vendor.

6. May a respondent submit for consideration proprietary curricula, materials and training offered commercially throughout the United States on a “fixed unit price basis rather than on a “cost reimbursement” basis?

**Answer:** Yes, it is based on a fixed unit price.

7. If a respondent submits for consideration proprietary curricula, materials and training offered commercially throughout the United States on a “fixed unit price” basis rather than on a “cost reimbursement” basis, will the form of agreement contained in Exhibit 13 be applicable? If so, to what would the agreement apply?

**Answer:** Yes, Exhibit 13 will be applicable. This is a State mandated boilerplate. Agreement will be based on a fixed unit price.
